RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 11-TM-02

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA THAT;

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended , and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well being of its members; and

WHEREAS, Te-Moak Tribal Council is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

WHEREAS, the South Fork Band Council by Resolution #11-SF-04 did submit and approve the May 2009 Long Range Transportation Planning Study (LRTP) to improve and upgrade roads on the South Fork Reservation and authorized the South Fork Band Council Chairman or his designated representative to take the necessary action needed to implement projects identified in the May 2009 LRTP; and

WHEREAS, the BIA-Western Regional Office, Division of Transportation, has requested specific authorization for a right-of-way for purpose of improving and upgrading a 4.44 mile section of Indian Route 1 (Lee Road) for the South Fork Band of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Indians.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Indians of Nevada hereby supports the South Fork Band Council for a right-of-way for the improvement and upgrading of the above road located on the South Fork Indian Reservation.
