RESOLUTION NO: 11-TM-07

**A Resolution Authorizing Submission of Proposals to the U.S. Department of Justice under: Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation; and the COPS Resources and COPS Hiring Grant Programs.**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well being of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Te-Moak Tribe and the duly elected representative body of the Te-Moak Tribal Council by the authority of the Tribe's Constitution and By-Laws, as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribe recognized the Te-Moak Western Shoshone Law Enforcement Services Department of Public Safety dba Western Shoshone Department of Public Safety as the provider of Law Enforcement Services for Elko Band Council, Battle Mountain Band Council, and Wells Band Council through Tribal Resolution #07-TM-23; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribe supports the Te-Moak Western Shoshone Law Enforcement Services Department of Public Safety to apply for funding through the U.S. Department of Justice Programs to support the above initiatives, including: the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation; and the COPS Resources and COPS Hiring Grant Programs; as well as other Federal, State or Regional Grants.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Te-Moak Tribal Council hereby supports the above program initiatives and efforts of the Te-Moak Western Shoshone Department of Public Safety and assures the Tribe's participation, if funded.

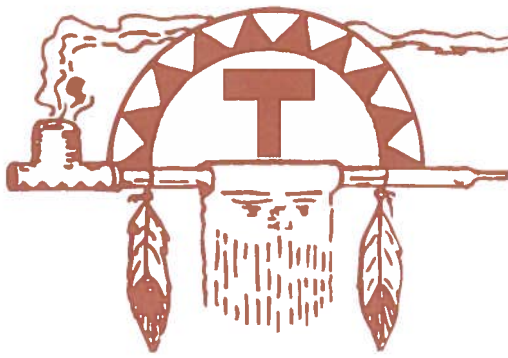

RESOLUTION NO: 11-TM-06

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the communities of Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

**WHEREAS**, Te-Moak Tribal Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-01 as amended by Ordinance Number 82-ORD-TM-03 provides for the issuing of liquor licenses; and


**WHEREAS**, in accordance to the Te-Moak Liquor Ordinance 82-ORD-TM-03, section 1, paragraph (d) No such License shall be issued without the approval of the local governing body of the Colony or Reservation of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Nevada, upon the territory of which the proposed alcoholic beverage business is seeking to be licensed; and

**WHEREAS**, at a duly held meeting of the Elko Band Council on March 30, 2011 Resolution #2011-EBC-07 was adopted to approve a Liquor License for Sarah M. Catt for the NV East Roller Girls Event, "Horseshoes and Hand Grenades for April 16, 2011 to be held at the Elko Colony Gymnasium; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council hereby approves a Liquor License for NV East Roller Girls Event with a administrative fee charge of \$250.00 to be made payable to the Te-Moak Tribe for processing as per Te-Moak Resolution #10-TM-19 adopted on July 7, 2010.
