RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO.: 12-TM-27

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the communities of Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Eastern Nevada Agency has prepared the 2012 Chimney Fire Burned Area Emergency Response (BAER) Emergency Stabilization (ES) Plan in cooperation with Agency officials, staff from the Bureau of Land Management, Elko District and the South Fork Band of Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone for the South Fork Indian Reservation under the jurisdiction of the Eastern Nevada Agency, and

WHEREAS, access must be restricted to livestock for at least two growing season to allow for prescribed seeded species to fully establish; and

WHEREAS, the ES Plan prepared by the BIA, Western Region, BAER Team has been reviewed by the BIA Eastern Nevada Agency and South Fork Council for the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone supports the South Fork Band Council and concurs with the 2012 Chimney Fire Burned Area Emergency Response (BAER) Emergency Stabilization Plan recommendations prepared by the BIA, Western Region BAER Team and advocated deferment of livestock to the treated area(s) from grazing.
